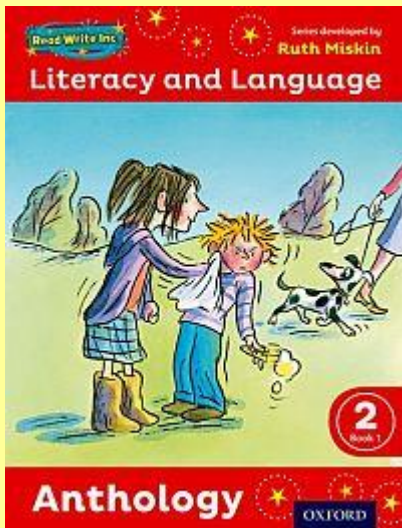


In Year 1/2, children are taught in their own classes for all lessons apart from Read Write Inc.

Literacy and Language

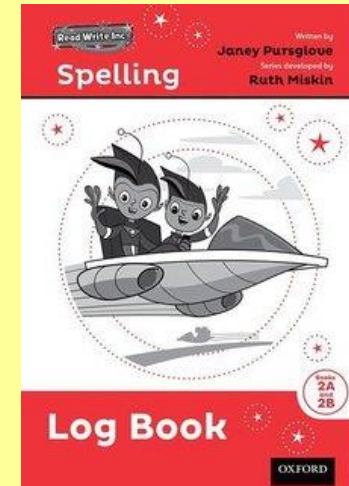
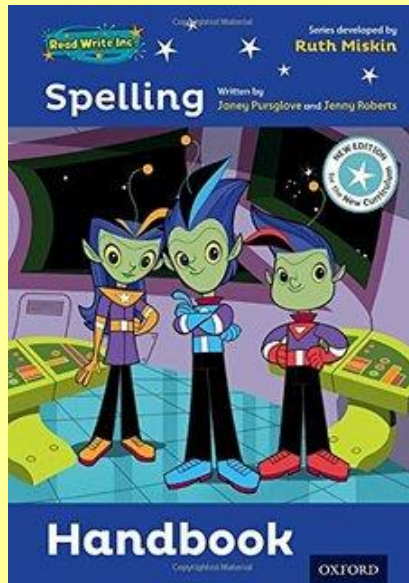


- Complete literacy programme

Maths

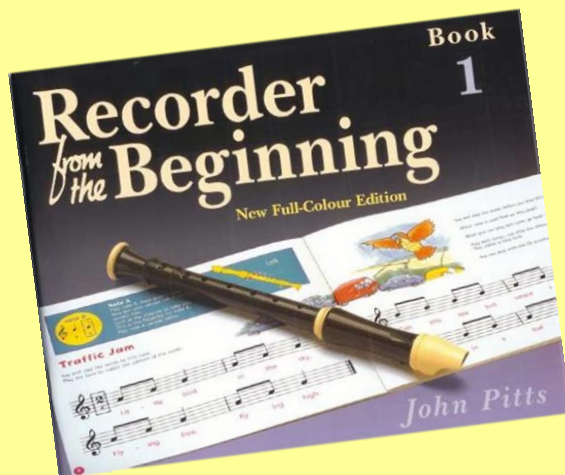
- Children will stay with their own class teacher for maths.

Singing and Recorders

- Year 1s will have singing on a Friday afternoon
- Year 2s will have the opportunity to learn to play the recorder.
- The year 2 children will need a basic descant recorder (around £5-£10) and the book titled:

Recorder from the beginning book 1 (around £3.50)

REFRESHMENTS

- All children have access to water although we encourage all children to have their own named water bottle in school each day
- 15 minute morning break
- Fruit snacks can be brought to school for break times
- Tuck shop tokens can be bought before school from the bandstand on Friday mornings (£1 for 10 tokens)
- Tokens can be spent at tuck shop during Friday break time



LUNCH TIME

- Children can have hot school meals or packed lunch. If the weather is nice, packed lunches may be eaten on the field.
- The games space and trim trail are used on a rota basis by every year group.



AT THE END OF THE DAY

- Our school day finishes at 3:20pm



- Children will be dismissed by their class teacher to their parent or carer at the end of the day

- Parents must give written permission for children to walk home alone

- If your Y5/6 child walks home alone and needs the use of a mobile phone, this must be handed in to their class teacher at the start of the school day

Homework

Homework procedures are currently under review.

In the meantime your child will bring home:

- A reading book which should be brought in bags every day. Books will usually be changed and returned on a Monday in Year 3/4
- A times tables mat
- A spelling list for their year group



We encourage children to put as much effort into homework as class work and to present their work neatly with joined up handwriting.

Please use a pencil or a black ink pen for their written work, and only pencil crayons for colouring.
