Pupil Premium was used to support pupils in the following way
1:1 personalised tuition for pupils in Y6 who were not making good progress in maths, reading or writing
Intervention groups to support learning across the school
Enrichment of the curriculum by supporting the costs of school trips to engage pupil learning

Impact
<p><u>Early Years Foundation Stage outcomes</u></p> <p>6 pupils were in receipt of pupil premium during EYFS. 5/6 attained at least 6 points in all areas of learning. 93% pupils achieved 78 points which is the national age-related expectation</p>
<p><u>Key Stage 1 outcomes</u></p> <p><u>Y1 phonics</u> 1 pupil was in receipt of pupil premium 0/1 attained the nationally expected level in the phonics screening check</p> <p><u>Year 2</u> 4 pupils were in receipt of the pupil premium 4/4 at Level 2 in mathematics with 2/4 achieving 2B or above 4/4 at Level 2 in reading with 4/4 achieving 2B or above 4/4 at Level 2 in writing with 3/4 achieving 2B or above</p>
<p><u>End of Key Stage 2</u></p> <p>5 pupils were in receipt of pupil premium during Y6. 3/5 made at least 2 levels progress in maths with 80% of pupils attaining L4 or above 4/5 made at least 2 levels progress in reading with 100% attaining L4 or above 2/5 made at least 2 levels progress in writing with 60% attaining L4 or above</p>
